Policy on Maintaining a List of Contractors

As a service to landowners and a means of encouraging the safe use of prescribed fire, the Michigan Prescribed Fire Council maintains a list of contractors who provide prescribed fire services for on a fee basis.

Inclusion of any company or name should not be interpreted as an endorsement by the Michigan Prescribed Fire Council or the agencies, organizations or individuals associated with the Council. This is simply a listing of those contractors the council is aware of.

- The council will only list those contractors who request listing by completing and returning the council's *Contractor Request for Listing* form.
- Contractors must renew their interest in being on the council's list by providing a new Request for Listing form every two years.
- Contractors must agree to adhere to the council's [Best Management Practices for Prescribed Fire](#) (BMP's) found on the council website.
- Additions or deletions to this list shall remain the right of the Michigan Prescribed Fire Council Steering Committee. The council reserves the right to remove those contractors who have shown through their actions that they are not adhering to the BMP's. The council also reserves the right to remove those contractors who have been found to be in violation of state law with regard to prescribed fire.
- The council is not a law enforcement body. The council will only take action to remove a contractor from its list as it becomes aware of a documented problem.
